

# Mapping the Impact:

## TEN YEARS OF BUILDING NEW OPPORTUNITIES IN OUR COMMUNITY



### FAMILY SUSTAINABILITY

- 1 Opportunity Hub - 87% of families who have partnered with our team have achieved one or more of their long-term goals.
- 2 Community Market - Distributed more than 350,000 meals and other basic supplies to families with emergent needs.

### EDUCATION PATHWAYS

- 3 Education Forward - Supported 223 adult learners in earning their GED. Graduates have gone on to earn 30% more, on average, than their peers.

### COMMUNITY LEADERSHIP

- 4 Outerspace - Transformed a vacant storefront into a community leadership hub. In total, more than \$1 million has been invested into the local economy by compensating residents for their leadership.
- 5 Meiser's Fresh Grocery + Deli - Our Community Leadership work has incubated 200 community leaders and resulted in more than 100 resident-led initiatives, including informing the design of the grocery store.
- 6 LPH Community Gardens - Supported three community garden spaces, public orchards, and more than a dozen home gardens, resulting in 10,000 pounds of fresh produce grown.

### NEIGHBORHOOD DEVELOPMENT

- 7 Saint Michael Campus - Invested \$12 million to restore our campus and expand our impact in the community.
- 8 The Sanctuary - Preserved the historic Saint Michael's Church as a primary gathering space in the neighborhood, hosting over 300 events since its reopening.
- 9 Washing Well - Renovated a vacant storefront into a community laundromat. Since opening, the Washing Well has helped an average of 530 families per year access affordable laundry, resulting in a total savings of \$4.3 million in laundry and transportation costs.
- 10 Community-Supported Housing - Launched affordable housing options for 6 households who partner with us on leadership development and other goals.
- 11 Joe Williams Family Center - Partnered with the Reds Community Fund to renovate the building for afterschool programming operated by Santa Maria Community Services.
- 12 Hatmaker Playground - Leveraged funding support from KaBOOM! and local partners to redesign the public playscape.
- 13 Deselaers Alley - Increased safety through the addition of lights, security cameras, planters, and general beautification efforts.
- 14 Habitat for Humanity Project - Partnered with Habitat for Humanity to transform 5 existing properties into new, affordable single-family homes, including 3 on Saint Michael Street, where properties went from 40% vacant to 100% occupied.
- 15 Lower Price Hill Thrives Project - Partnered with Over-the-Rhine Community Housing on the development of 47 new affordable apartments and 3 new community-benefitting storefronts.
- 16 2118 West 8th Street Project - Invested \$275,000 in the emergency stabilization of the property to preserve it for future development.
